

Enable Moonshot on a Client

To enable Moonshot authentication on an Application client, the device first needs the Moonshot libraries installed and configured, then the application client needs to be configured to use them.

Install Moonshot Libraries on a Client

Identity Selection

- Users need a way of selecting the identity they wish to use when authenticating to a Moonshot-enabled service. The Moonshot project provides software to do this: the [Moonshot Identity Selector](#) on Linux, and the [Moonshot Identity Manager](#) on macOS. Windows users also have an alternative: the built-in [Windows Credential Manager](#).

Configure a Client Application to Use Moonshot
